


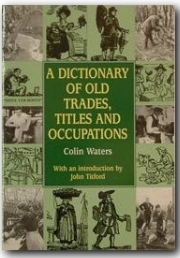
All books can be ordered in the normal way either via our website, telephone orders or come into the shop and see us.
