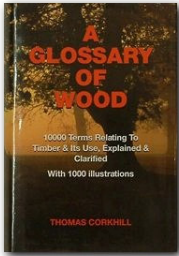
## Wood

All books can be ordered in the normal way either via our website, telephone orders or come into the shop and see us.

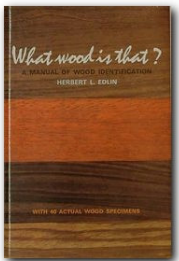

Post & packing is £3.95 to UK mainland for all orders under £50. Orders over £50 are sent free of charge to UK mainland addresses.

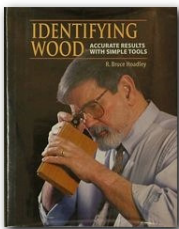

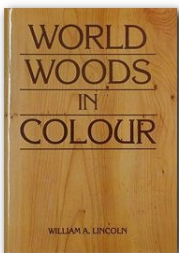
With the naked eye or a microscope you will be able to identify 180 hardwoods following the straightforward techniques described in this book.

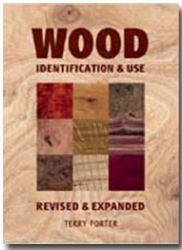

Over 200 woods, from acacia to zanthoxylum, are illustrated each with a page devoted to a superb colour photograph and information. Each wood is classified under its botanical name with its common name displayed. There is a very comprehensive index of common, scientific and local names as well as a glossary. Each page has details under the following headings: Description; Properties; Seasoning; Durability; Typical uses and possible health risks. A further 200 woods are listed briefly with properties in a 9 page directory at the end of the book.
